### ORDER TO REMEDY A VIOLATION

Dear Sir

Please be informed that you are in violation of the Town of Carmel Wetlands regulation under Chapter 89-4 B - (1) "*Depositing directly or indirectly, or permitting to be deposited, or removing or permitting to be removed, excavating, mining, dredging or filling, any material, debris, chemical waste or effluent.*" This activity refers to the clearing and grading of a Class 2 wetlands greater than 5,000 square feet located at the corner of Mt. Hope Road and Rt. 6 in Mahopac.

This wetland is in my opinion clearly regulated by Carmel Fresh Water Code Chapter 89 and is distinctly defined by existing vegetation and wetland soils as per Chapter 89-1-(2).

This work was done without a local permit from the Town of Carmel and is in violation of the above cited local law. You are therefor ordered pursuant to Chapter 89-17 (1) to return the wetlands it to it's original natural condition in consultation with the E.C.B. and myself.

You may appear before the Town of Carmel Environmental Conservation Board and request a permit for the above mentioned activity at their next scheduled meeting at Town Hall. You should call Mrs. Peggy Moore at 1 845 628 1500 to be placed on the agenda.

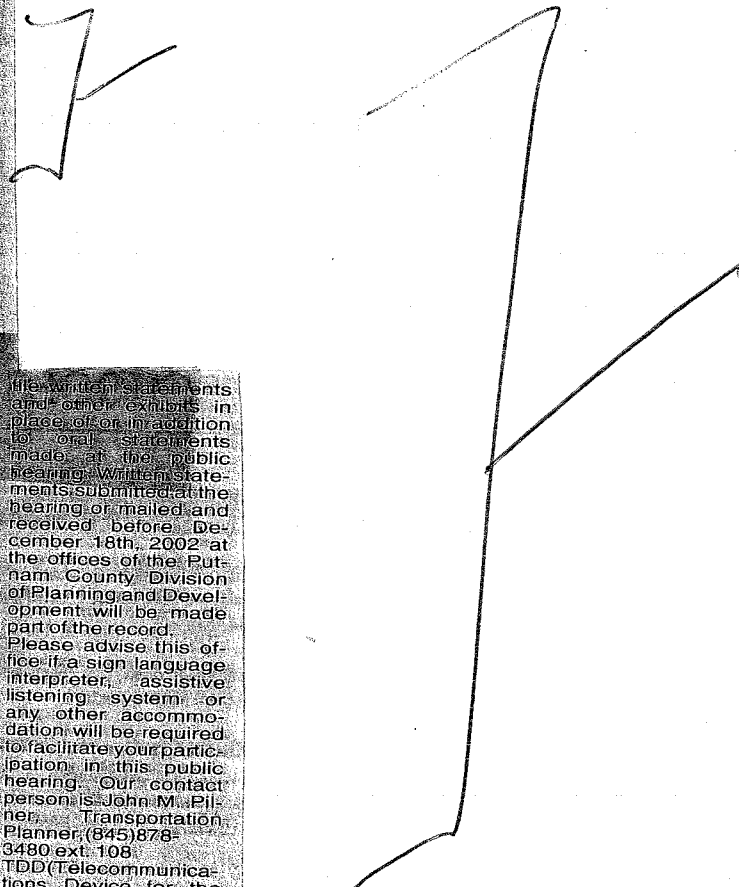
